



#### HOW TO DRAW A CROCODILE


You may follow this 8 step crocodile directed drawing to help you create your VISUALIZATION illustrations for *The Watermelon Seed.* 






4. Draw bottom of mouth.

Trace with marker and color.


Roll a number cube that you have at home or pick a number 1-6..

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Find the words under the number that you rolled.


Read the words in the column and color the number cube. Roll again until all six number cubes are colored..




