
• Complete 20 minutes of iReady MATH lessons.

SCIENCE & SS



RELIGION


- Begin your lesson by singing <u>1, 2, 3 Jesus Is Alive</u>

- End your religion lesson by singing and dancing to <u>L, O, V, E,</u> <u>LOVE</u>.




The Easter Bunny's Assistant
