LITERACY

iREADY

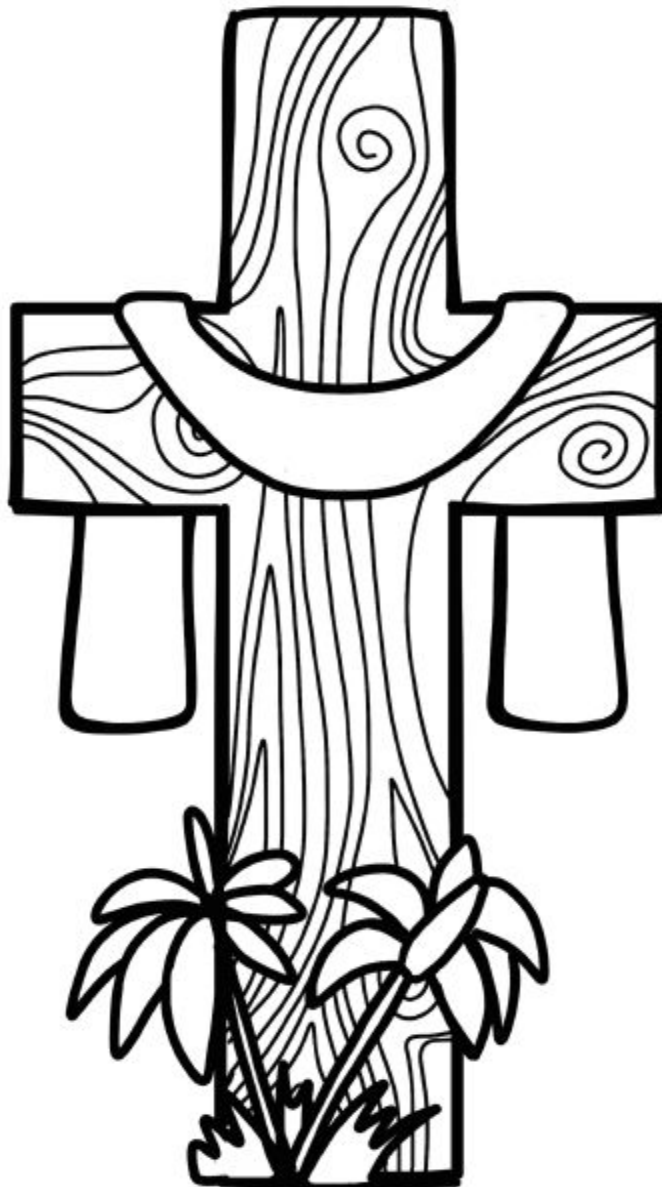
- Complete 20 minutes of iReady READING lessons.

RELIGION


- Begin your lesson by singing [1, 2, 3, Jesus Is Alive.](#)
