Dear Parents,

As you may be aware, we are anticipating the outcome of Police Officer Jason Van Dyke's murder trial in the next few days. The safety of our students is always our highest priority and we want our parents to know we are taking the necessary precautions to assure a peaceful environment within our school. We are closely monitoring this case and are in daily contact with the Chicago Police Department for updates. The CPD will be assigning a tactical unit designated just for schools from 103rd-115th street and from California Ave. to Western Ave. Below are additional safety measures that have or will be taken during the time of the trial.

- Our Staff has met to review our Emergency Lockdown procedures and have also practiced with the children.
- All staff members are equipped with a safety bags, which includes our safety plan, emergency supplies and an all-school contact list.
- We are considering a "Soft Lockdown" the day the verdict is released, meaning movement can take place within our building but no one can transition outside. Lunch and recess would be inside the classrooms (hot lunch will be brought to the children).
- If necessary, extracurricular activities may be cancelled.
- Timely eblasts will be sent to parents as needed and updated will be posted to the school websitewww.stcajetanschool.org.
- School closure would only be considered if St. Cajetan was in immediate danger.
- If you are not personally comfortable with the situation occurring in our area, know that you may decide to keep your child(ren) at home. Please note, if we are in a Lockdown situation, NO students will be released at that time.
