Updates for 2018-2019 School Year

Uniforms:

Uniforms are worn by all K-8th grade students. The uniform stores listed below will know exactly what you need when you walk in so don't worry about having all of this information with you when you shop.

- Jumpers will be worn in grades K-3rd. Skirts will be worn for girls in grades 4th- 8th (please note you can cut the jumper and make it into a skirt so this should help save money).
- The K-3 girls' shirts will be a RED polo. If your daughter(s) wears a jumper, you can just buy a plain red polo. If your daughter(s) wears pants or shorts, they must have a polo with our embroidered St. Cajetan logo.
- The 4th-8th grade girls' shirts will be a RED polo with the band at the bottom. This shirt must be embroidered with our St. Cajetan logo.
- All boys shirts will be GRAY with an embroidered St. Cajetan logo.
- All other uniform components (pants, shorts, socks without no logos, sweaters) will remain the same.

All uniform items can be purchased from **Schoolbelles or Schools R Us**, but please note Schoolbelles does not carry our boys shirts. We will be sending home coupons for each store in the report card envelope. Original coupons must be in hand to earn the discount.

Computer Fee: \$90 (per student)

The computer fee not only assists with the cost of the Technology position, but it also supplements the cost of maintaining the infrastructure, internet costs, school-wide devices, technology systems, and SBTC monthly consultant costs.

Book Fee: \$240 (per student)

This fee is used to purchase the textbooks/ programs the student will use during the school year. Some of this fee is used to support our online textbooks (Jr. High Religion, Social Studies, Math, Scope Reading).

Curriculum Fee: \$100 (per family)

The Curriculum Fee is used to offset the cost of our professional development, training and school-wide programming (MobyMax, Reading and Writing Workshop, etc.).

Lunch Fee: \$90 (per family)

The lunch fee is used to pay the teachers/ staff members that work during the lunch periods and also offset the cost of the new online ordering system- My School Account.

Tuition Waiver Program: \$90 (per family)

In the event of the death of a parent or legal guardian and in correlation with financial hardship, the Tuition Waiver Program will provide tuition for children currently enrolled in the Program for the balance of their education at St. Cajetan School.

(If you have a child in 5 Day/ Full Day Preschool and they have older siblings in the school, you will qualify for the regular K-8 tuition rate).
